## **CLUB APPLICATION FORM 2014-15**

When complete this form should be printed & posted to the General Secretary Frank Thompson with a cheque for the full amount payable to "Surrey Youth League". Forms need to be received by the 30th April 2014 to guarantee a league place next season. Incomplete forms or those without payment WILL NOT be processed. There will be an additional fee of £10 per team for entries after the AGM.

Please note that as an FC Charter Standard League we will only be processing applications from Charter Standard Clubs or those who demonstrate a commitment to achieving it in the foreseeable future. This does not prevent non Charter Standard clubs from applying but it does mean that they will need to highlight their intentions below and contact Frank Thompson ASAP to get an agreed plan in place. The League has the right to refuse membership to a current member Club if it fails to demonstrate commitment to achieving the award. We will help clubs as much as possible with your application but clubs must have an achievable plan.

New Clubs are very welcome but must have realistic expectations on their divisional placing; they will not generally ever be offered a place in the top division. They will be offered a place where there is space and where it is wholly suitable to the new club and also the existing teams in the age group. If you are not FA Charter Standard then you will need to outline the plan to the League before acceptance. First drafts of the divisions are normally published 7 -14 days after the AGM.
