Please note that as an FC Charter Standard League we will only be processing applications from Charter Standard Clubs or those who demonstrate a commitment to achieving it in the foreseeable future. This does not prevent non Charter Standard clubs from applying but it does mean that they will need to highlight their intentions below and contact Frank Thompson ASAP to get an agreed plan in place. **The League has the right to refuse membership to a current member Club if it has failed to demonstrate commitment to achieving the award. We will help clubs as much as possible with their application but the clubs must have an achievable plan.**

New Clubs are very welcome but must have realistic expectations on their divisional placing; they will not generally ever be offered a place in the top division. They will be offered a place where there is space and where it is wholly suitable to the new club and also the existing teams in the age group.
