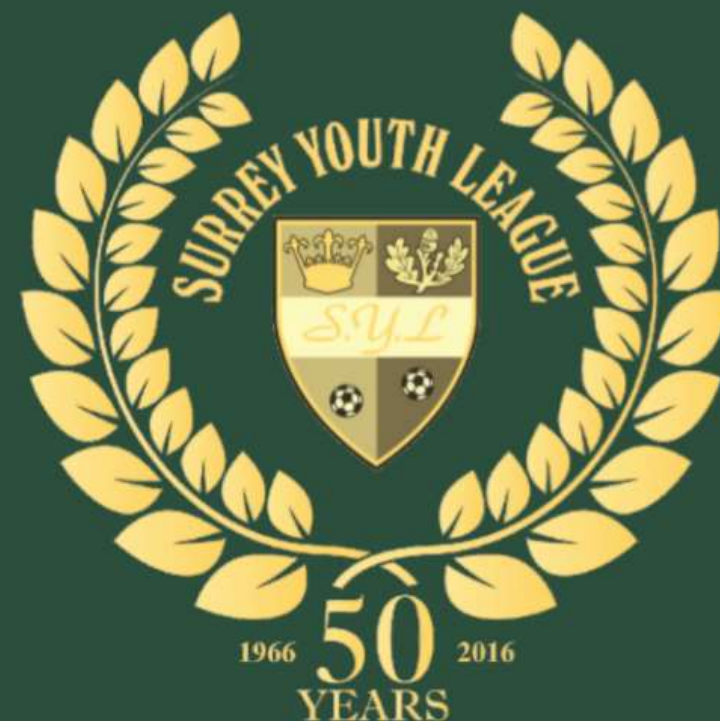

Play your part and support The FA's Code of Respect:

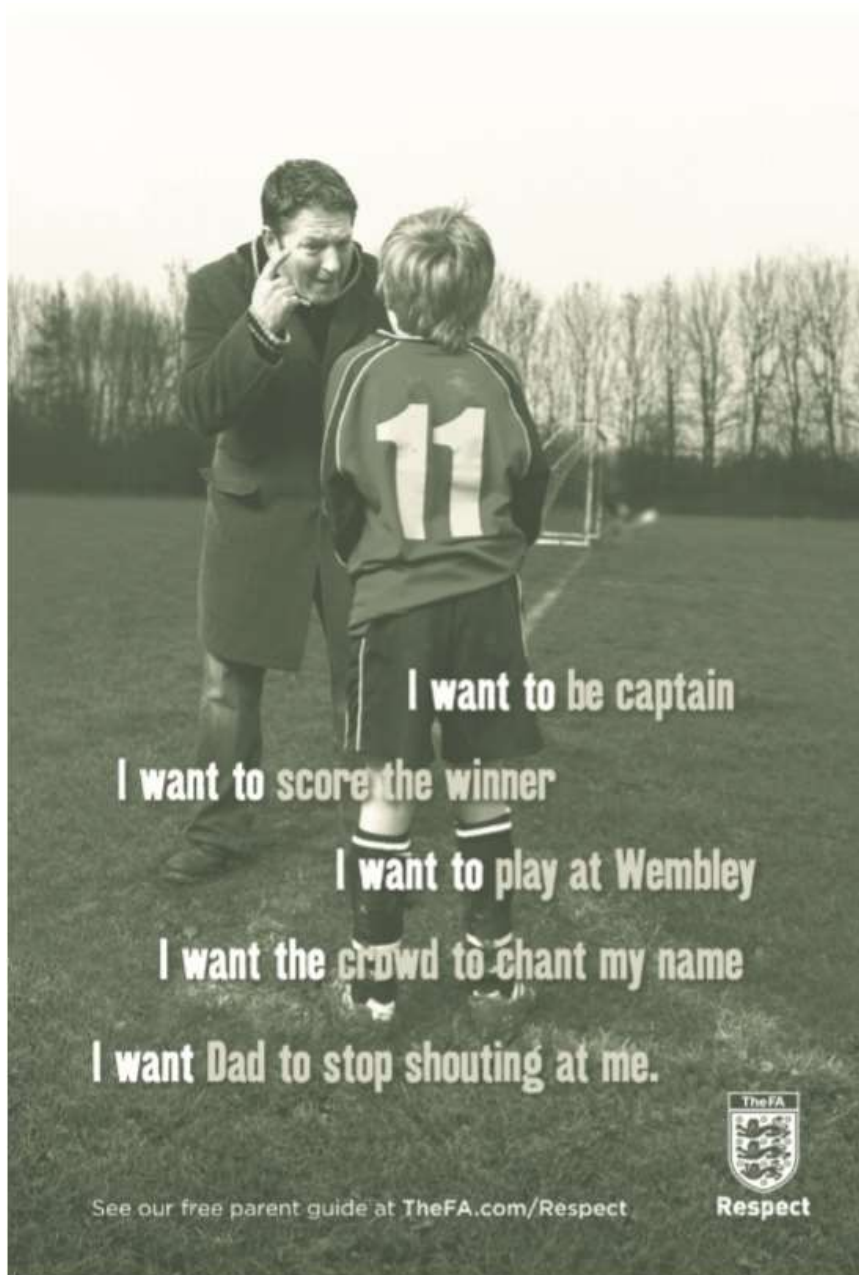
- Have fun; it's what we're all here for!
